

45 : 1 IN FĪNEM FĪLIĪS CORE PRŌ ARCĀNĪS PSALMUS:

Unto the end, for the sons of Core, for the hidden.

45 : 2 Deus noster refugium et virtūs: adjūtor in trībulātiōnibus
quae invēnērunt nōs nimis.

Our God is our refuge and strength: a helper in troubles, which have found us exceedingly.

45 : 3 Proptereā nōn timēbimus dum turbābitur terra, et
trānsferentur montēs in cor maris.

Therefore we will not fear, when the earth shall be troubled; and the mountains shall be removed into the heart of the sea.

45 : 4 Sonuērunt, et turbātae sunt aquae eōrum; conturbātī sunt
montēs in fortitūdine ejus.

Their waters roared and were troubled; the mountains were troubled with his strength.

45 : 5 Flūminis impetus laetificat cīvitātem Deī: sānctificāvit
tabernāculum suum Altissimus.

The rushing of the river maketh the city of God joyful: the most High hath sanctified his own tabernacle.

45 : 6 Deus in mediō ejus, nōn commovēbitur: adjuvābit eam Deus
māne dīlūculō.

God is in the midst thereof, it shall not be moved: God will help it in the morning early.

45 : 7 Conturbātae sunt gentēs, et inclīnāta sunt rēgna; dedit vōcem
suam, mōta est terra.

Nations were troubled, and kingdoms were bowed down; he uttered his voice, the earth trembled.

45 : 8 Dominus virtūtum nōbīscum: susceptor noster Deus Iācōb.

The Lord of armies is with us: the God of Jacob is our protector.

45 : 9 Venīte, et vidēte opera Domini, quae posuit prōdigia super
terram,

Come and behold ye the works of the Lord: what wonders he hath done upon earth,

45 : 10 auferēs bella usque ad finem terrae. Arcum conteret, et
cōnfringet arma, et scūta combūret ignī:

Making wars to cease even to the end of the earth. He shall destroy the bow, and break the weapons: and the shield he shall burn in the fire.

45 : 11 Vacāte, et vidēte quoniam ego sum Deus: exaltābor in
gentibus, et exaltābor in terrā.

Be still and see that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, and I will be exalted in the earth.
