**69 : 1 IN FĪNEM PSALMUS DĀVĪD IN REMEMORĀTIŌNEM QUOD
SALVUM FĒCERIT EUM DOMINUS:**

Unto the end, a psalm for David, to bring to remembrance that the Lord saved him.

**69 : 2 Deus in adjūtōrium meum intende; Domine, ad adjuvandum
mē festīnā.**

O God, come to my assistance; O Lord, make haste to help me.

69 : 3 Cōfundantur, et revereantur, quī quaerunt animam meam.

Let them be confounded and ashamed that seek my soul.

**69 : 4 Āvertantur retrōrsum, et ērubēscant, quī volunt mihī mala;
āvertantur statim ērubēsentēs, quī dīcunt mihī: Eugē, eugē.**

Let them be turned backward, and blush for shame that desire evils to me; let them be presently turned away blushing for shame that say to me: Well done, well done.

**69 : 5 Exsultent et laetentur in tē omnēs quī quaerunt tē, et dīcant
semper: Magnificētur Dominus, quī dīligunt salūtāre tuum.**

Let all that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee, and let them say always: The Lord be magnified, those who love thy salvation.

**69 : 6 Ego vērō egēnus et pauper sum; Deus, adjuvā mē. Adjūtor
meus et līberātor meus es tū; Domine, nē morēris.**

But I am needy and poor; O God, help me. Thou art my helper and my deliverer; O Lord, make no delay.
