

PSALMUS 109

109 : 1 **PSALMUS DĀVĪD: Dīxit Dominus Dominō meō: Sedē ā dextrīs
meīs, dōnec pōnam inimīcōs tuōs scabellum pedum tuōrum.**

A psalm for David: The Lord said to my Lord: Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thy enemies thy footstool.

109 : 2 **Virgam virtūtis tuae ēmittet Dominus ex Siōn; domināre in
mediō inimīcōrum tuōrum.**

The Lord will send forth the sceptre of thy power out of Sion; rule thou in the midst of thy enemies.

109 : 3 **Tēcum prīncipium in diē virtūtis tuae, in splendōribus
sānctōrum; ex uterō ante lūciferum genuī tē.**

With thee is the principality in the day of thy strength, in the brightness of the saints; from the womb before the day star I begot thee.

109 : 4 **Jūrāvit Dominus, et nōn poenitēbit eum: Tū es sacerdōs in
aeternum secundum ordinem Melchisedech.**

The Lord hath sworn, and he will not repent: Thou art a priest for ever according to the order of Melchisedech.

109 : 5 **Dominus ā dextrīs tuīs; cōnfrēgit in diē irae suae rēgēs.**

The Lord is at thy right hand; he hath broken kings in the day of his wrath.

109 : 6 **Jūdicābit in nātiōnibus, implēbit ruīnās; conquassābit capita
in terrā multōrum.**

He shall judge among nations, he shall fill ruins; he shall crush the heads in the land of many.

109 : 7 **Dē torrente in viā bibet; propterea exaltābit caput.**

He shall drink of the torrent in the way; therefore shall he lift up the head.
