

PSALMUS 121

121 : 1 CANTICUM GRADUUM: Laetātus sum in hīs quae dicta sunt
mihī: In domum Dominī ībimus.

A gradual canticle. I rejoiced at the things that were said to me: We shall go into the house of the Lord.

121 : 2 Stantēs erant pedēs nostrī, in ātriīs tuīs Jerusalem.

Our feet were standing in thy courts, O Jerusalem.

121 : 3 Jerusalem, quae aedificātur ut cīvitās, cuius participātiō ejus
in idipsum.

Jerusalem, which is built as a city, which is compact together.

121 : 4 Illūc enim ascendērunt tribūs, tribūs Dominī, testimōnium
Isrāhēl, ad cōfitendum nōminī Dominī.

For thither did the tribes go up, the tribes of the Lord: the testimony of Israel, to praise the name of the Lord.

121 : 5 Quia illīc sēdērunt sēdēs in jūdicīō, sēdēs super domum Dāvīd.

Because their seats have sat in judgment, seats upon the house of David.

121 : 6 Rogāte quae ad pācem sunt Jerusalem, et abundantīā
dīligentibus tē.

Pray ye for the things that are for the peace of Jerusalem: and abundance for them that love thee.

121 : 7 Fīat pāx in virtūte tuā, et abundantia in turribus tuīs.

Let peace be in thy strength: and abundance in thy towers.

121 : 8 Propter frātrēs meōs et proximōs meōs, loquēbar pācem dē tē.

For the sake of my brethren, and of my neighbours, I spoke peace of thee.

121 : 9 Propter domum Dominī Deī nostrī, quaesīvī bona tibi.

Because of the house of the Lord our God, I have sought good things for thee.
