

PSALMUS 130

130 : 1 CANTICUM GRADUUM DĀVĪD: Domine nōn est exaltātum cor meum, neque ēlātī sunt oculī meī, neque ambulāvī in magnīs, neque in mīrābilibus super mē.

A gradual canticle of David. Lord, my heart is not exalted: nor are my eyes lofty. Neither have I walked in great matters, nor in wonderful things above me.

130 : 2 Sī nōn humiliter sentiēbam, sed exaltāvī animam meam, sicut ablactātus est super mātrem suā, ita retribūtiō in animā meā.

If I was not humbly minded, but exalted my soul, as a child that is weaned is towards his mother, so reward in my soul.

130 : 3 Spēret Israhēl in Dominō, ex hoc nunc et usque in saeculum.

Let Israel hope in the Lord, from henceforth now and for ever.
